What services do you offer your clients?

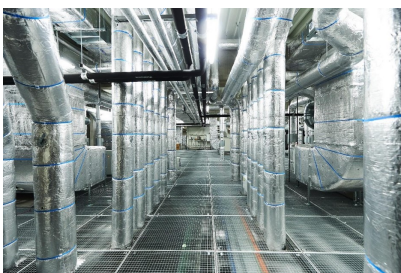
We offer an integrated and personalised approach, including:
